CLAIM YOUR REBATE

Are you planning on upgrading your current furnace? Remember, the Gas Co. offers a rebate of up to \$200.00 for your new 94% efficient natural gas furnace that is your primary heating source for the residence.

Don't forget to install a new programmable thermostat and possibly be eligible to receive a \$25.00 rebate.

A rebate of \$150.00 may be available if you replace your old propane or electric water heater with a new energy-efficient natural gas water heater.
